Our friendly and experienced WorkWell team will help patients stay in work or return to work if they have had to give up their job due to a health-related condition. This includes self-employed workers.

What we offer:

- a personal assessment to understand the best support for your patient's needs
- tailored plans to address their physical and mental wellbeing
- access to local health services, wellbeing activities, and community support
- careers advice and guidance to help individuals progress in their current job or explore new opportunities
- a dedicated WorkWell Community Connector or Health and Work Coach

Eligibility:

Patients can access WorkWell if they are employed, self-employed, or recently unemployed and facing health-related challenges to either remain in work, or return to work. **To refer patients** to WorkWell, please use existing referral arrangements such as Wellbeing Matters social prescribing via EMIS on the patient record, or your tailored referral pathway.
